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Indianapolis 500 Fastest Rookie Qualifier Signs Window World Stinger Benefitting St. Jude Children's Research Hospital

NORTH WILKESBORO, N.C. — Window World®, America's largest window replacement and home remodeling company, continues its national tour of The Stinger, a centennial tribute to the first winning Indianapolis 500 car, the 1911 Marmon Wasp. The Stinger, featuring a collection of Indy 500 starter signatures, made the trip to Nashville, Tenn. to appear at last week's annual Window World National Sales Meeting. On Wednesday, August 13, 2014, John Hollansworth, Jr., the 1996 SCCA Valvoline Runoffs National Champion (Spec Racer Class), added his name to The Stinger, benefitting St. Jude Children's Research Hospital®.

Hollansworth Jr., whose career spanned 12 IndyCar races between 1999 and 2001 and included being the fastest rookie qualifier for the 1999 Indianapolis 500, is a second generation driver, following the footsteps of his father, John Hollansworth, Sr. While racing, John paid homage to his father by wearing Hollansworth, Sr.'s racing number, 42.

The Stinger was displayed throughout Window World's conference, often referred to as its Family Reunion, where over 1,300 members of the organization gathered from across the nation. Window World featured Hollansworth's Stinger signing, the 245th of its kind, on the opening night of the week's festivities.

The collection of signatures amounts to much more than racing memorabilia. Unveiled at the 100th anniversary of the Indy 500, The Stinger was designed by Window World in collaboration with John Andretti and Andretti Autosport to fundraise for St. Jude, the world's leading treatment center of pediatric cancer and other catastrophic illnesses. The car is to be auctioned, with 100% of the proceeds going to the hospital. In addition to the funds to be raised in its eventual sale, The Stinger garners monetary support each time a signature is added, as Window World, Inc. makes a \$189 donation to its charitable foundation, Window World Cares®. This signature brings the fundraising total to \$46,305.
